Topics

- **Obstacles you have encountered when administering CVA programs or projects**
- **"Reasonable open periods" as in the current rule, is very open ended. Do we need more in the regulation? Or, should we add in the Appendix as BMP? Some suggestions:**
 - Pumpout/dump stations must be open during the same period the fuel docks are normally open.
 - Pumpout stations must be open when the marina is open and staff is present to pump out boats.
 - Pumpout/dump stations must be open during the hours considered to be normal marina business hours as adjusted by seasonal differences.
 - Pumpout /dumpstations should be open during hours that encourage boaters usage.
 - Other?
